Split 4 ways is \$31.25 per day or \$125.00 for 4 days or \$187.50 for 6 days.

A #11 (2 breakfast burritos, hash brown & beverage for \$5.00) and A # 12 (2 cheese burgers, fries and a coke for \$6.00) round out your creature comforts, which are well provided for at only \$11.00 per day or \$44.00 for 4 days or \$66.00 for six days.

$\$125.00 + \$44.00 = \$169.00$ for a 4 day Super Saver
 $\$187.00 + \$66.00 = \$253.00$ for a 6 day Super Saver
Quite a savings!

We assume all will chip in for gas & stuff to help out the driver, if you drive to the Open. A cab will cost \$6 to \$8 one way (within a couple of miles of the courts) + tip

Of course if you only stay three to a room your motel cost goes up 25% and
If you stay two to a room your hotel cost goes up 50 %.

\$210.00 & \$294.00 respectfully for a 4-night stay &
\$316.00 & \$441.00, respectfully for a 6-night stay

Some of you have asked for a modestly priced hotel because you prefer to room alone. The foregoing numbers translated for single usage are:

\$544.00 for a 4-night stay & \$816.00 for a 6-night stay!
